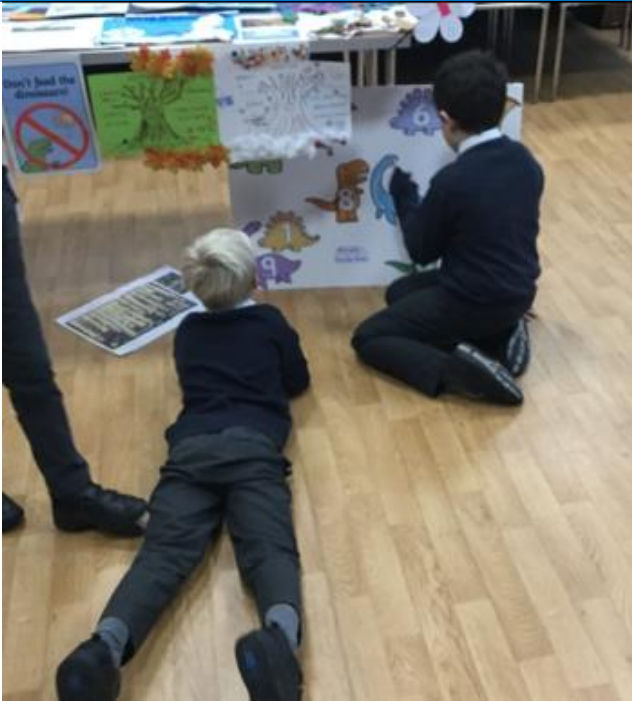
## Homework Exhibition
