



Blended Learning – 2020-2021

Microsoft Teams

You all have a Microsoft Teams account that will be set up for each child in the school. This system will allow your child's learning to continue, away from school, in a multitude of ways, for example: teachers will use the platform to share and receive tasks; live feedback sessions, led by teachers, will ensure pupils can continue to improve; and resources created by the teachers to aid the learning process will be made accessible.

Loom

Loom is an online presentation tool. This enables the teacher to prepare a lesson input which can be shared for you to watch at a time suitable for your household.

Purple Mash and **Times Tables Rockstars** remain as online tools to support basic skills such as reading, spelling and times tables.

Please see below how these tools will be used:

Individual child/ren in self-isolation and are in good health to continue learning at home	<p>Children will be sent an A4 sheet explaining the tasks set for the week. These tasks will be the same tasks the children in school will be completing.</p> <p>The work is to be brought in with your child when they return to school so that they can receive feedback on their learning. This will ensure that your child does not fall behind the work that is taking place during their time of self-isolation.</p>
Whole class bubble needs to self-isolate due to a positive covid-19 test within the bubble	<p>Learning for the whole class becomes remote. Class teachers will send out Loom lesson inputs for the children to watch and complete the associated work. The lesson inputs will be short and include modelled examples of what the children have to do.</p> <p>The children will have a deadline to complete the work and submit it via Microsoft Teams.</p> <p>The class teacher will check the work and then invite the children, in small groups, for online feedback. Feedback is proven to be one of the most powerful ways to move learning forward. Holding live feedback sessions will ensure that misconceptions can be addressed and next steps provided. If the children need to do</p>

	<p>further work to show understanding, it will be shared in this tailored feedback session.</p> <p>Reception children Class teachers will share learning via Loom with clear instructions of what learning to practise at home. The expectations for what the children are to complete will alter as their learning skills develop.</p>
Whole school closure	<p>As per current guidance, key groups will still attend school.</p> <p>Remote learning will set up so that all pupils can continue their education from home as per the bubble closure model.</p>

The provision will be continually reviewed so that we can be sure that we are providing the children with the best possible remote learning experience.
