

## Personal, Social, Emotional Development

We will learning how to work and play co-operatively and take turns with others.

We will continue to form positive attachments to adults and friendships with our peers.

We will set and work towards simple goals, and develop the ability to wait for what we want and control our immediate impulses when appropriate.

## Physical Development

We will revise and refine the fundamental movement skills we have already acquired: rolling, crawling, walking, jumping, running, hopping, skipping, climbing.

Further develop and refine a range of ball skills.

Develop our small motor skills to be able to use a range of tools competently, safely and confidently. Such as pencils, paintbrushes, scissors, knives, forks and spoons.

## Communication and Language

We will be learning how to ask questions to find out more and to check our understanding.

We will practice articulating our ideas and thoughts in well-formed sentences.

We will also practice connecting one idea or action to another using a range of connectives.

## Literacy

We will be practicing forming our upper and lower case letters accurately.

We will be writing sentences using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

We will re read our sentences to check they make sense.

We will be continuing to read words that are consistent with our phonic knowledge by sound blending.
