

## Personal, Social, Emotional Development

We will learn how to show sensitivity to our own and other's needs.

We will practice focusing our attention and responding appropriately to questions and comments when engaged in play and during lesson time.

We will practice following instructions which involve several ideas or actions.

## Physical Development

We will practice negotiating space and obstacles safely.

We will learn how to use a range of small tools accurately including scissors and paintbrushes.

We will practice showing accuracy and care when drawing.

We will ensure we have a tripod grip when we hold a pencil in preparation for fluent writing.

## Communication and Language

We will learn new vocabulary and apply in different contexts.

We will practice listening attentively and responding with relevant questions, comments and actions during whole class discussions and group work.

We will learn how to ask for clarification to support our understanding.

## Literacy

We will learn how to anticipate key events in stories.

We will practice reading aloud simple sentences.

We will continue to learn common exception words.

We will continue writing simple sentences that can be read by others.

We will begin to use adjectives and conjunctions in our writing.
