

## Personal, Social, Emotional Development

We will be talking about emotions and developing the children's vocabulary to help them explain how they are feeling.

We will be learning about empathy to help us understand how somebody else is feeling.

We will be helping the children to resolve conflicts in their play by giving them strategies to regulate their emotions and finding solutions and compromise.

## Physical Development

We will continue learning basic principles of a PE lesson such as safely using space, stopping safely, using and sharing equipment and working individually, with a partner and group. We will take part in activities which will develop fundamental movement skills such as running, jumping and skipping.

Children will also play simple games and begin to understand and use rules.

## Communication and Language

We will be learning how to express our point of view and how to debate when we do not agree with somebody else.

We will be developing our listening and understanding skills by following a question or instruction with two parts.

We will be thinking about the question word "why" and how to answer a question that begins with it.

## Literacy

We will continue to learn the initial code and begin the extended code in phonics.

We will continue to blend sounds together to form simple CVC words (ie. cat, dig, pot)

We will begin guided reading sessions.



We will use some of our print and letter knowledge in writing.

## Understanding the World

Through our sessions at Forest School we will begin to understand the need to respect and care for the natural environment and all living things and using our senses to explore natural materials.

Through our Science topic "Frozen" we will be exploring how ice is formed and how it melts.

We will be looking at different climates in different countries and we will talk about how they differ.

## Mathematics

We will be learning about 2D and 3D shapes and discussing their properties.

We will continue to explore number by finding one more and one less than a given number.

We will explore positional language to explain where an object is (ie. under the table).

We will describe a sequence of events (ie. first, next..).
