Covid-19 DfE Guidance

In the last few days we have received guidance of the measures needed in schools after the 19th July 2021. In line with the lifting of restrictions in the general community, the need for bubbles, absence of gatherings such as assemblies and during breaktime has been removed. We are thrilled that this is the case and we know the positive impact this will have on the children's general school experience. Within the guidance, it states that if term ends after the 19th July, schools may decide to implement the changes in the new term. At LPPS, we have decided, given how far we have come, to keep all of the measures in place until the close of this term. We want as many children

and staff as possible to end the term without the need to isolate and we feel that this will give us the best chance of that. In addition, the routines are so well embedded that to change them for one week would be unsettling for some children and not support a positive end to the term.

Our risk assessment will be updated for the autumn term and you will be able to see the safety measures that will remain in place.

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Uniform

We have been fully understanding with items of uniform that have been replaced by non-uniform items in the last two terms. This has been in light of the pandemic and the need to minimise trips to the shops and replacing items that the children have grown out of.

When we return in September the expectation is that all children are in full, correct school uniform.

Children will still come into school in PE kit on PE days as this has proven to maximise PE lesson time and reduce lost property!

As you prepare for the purchase of new school uniform for September, here are some reminders for our soon to be Year 3 children.

Key Stage 2 Uniform

Winter: Grey skirt or trousers, white plain shirt, navy blue knitted cardigan with school logo, or navy-blue knitted jumper with school logo and school tie (compulsory).

Summer: Grey shorts, white plain shirt navy blue and white checked gingham dress.

Backpack (KS2 only)

PE KIT: House colour T-shirt with school logo, navy blue shorts or shorts with school logo, navy tracksuit bottoms or tracksuit bottoms with school logo, optional fleece with school logo and **trainers**. There is a larger PE bag available for Key Stage 2 pupils.

Hawksbrook – yellow

Eden – green

Wickham – blue
