Place Value to 20

- Counting to twenty forwards and Backwards from any given number 1 including 0.
- Count, read and write numbers to 20 in numerals and words.
- Identify one more and one less than a number.
- Represent and Identify numbers using objects and pictorial representation (e.g. number lines, part-whole models, numicon, cubes, dienes and bar models).

Shape

- Recognise and name common 2D shapes.
- Recognise and name common 3D shapes.

Power Of Reading and Literacy

The children will base their literacy every half term on a new book. This term we will be using *'The Lonely Beast'* by Chris Judge as our 'Power of Reading Book.' We will be covering the following.

- Discussing themes and issues that arise in the story whilst making connections with their own lives
- Developing creative responses to the text through drama, play and artwork
- Writing a newspaper article in role as a fictional character
- Writing a character description
- Writing a letter

'Dinosaur Planet'

All foundation subjects will be taught through a topic. This Half term's topic is 'Dinosaur Planet'.
