Dear Parents/Carers,

Although we find ourselves in an unexpected situation, we are pleased to be able to keep on teaching your child through Teams.

From Tuesday 5th January, year 2 teachers will pre-record English and maths sessions for your child to access at home via Microsoft Teams. These will be uploaded daily for you to access at the most convenient time for your family and will be available from 8.50am.

In each session, we will teach a concept following on with our planned learning for this half term. The children will then have both maths and English tasks to complete linked to each session. These tasks will be explained in the video which will be saved, along with any corresponding worksheets, in the appropriate folder on Microsoft Teams. Folders will be organised by day, e.g. Monday, and then sorted into sub folders for English and maths.

Completed work can be uploaded as a photo or document in the folder titled 'Completed Learning' which can be found in the maths and English sub folders. Please could work also be clearly labelled when saving to support organisation and retrieval. For example: Matthew Maths Monday 4th Jan.

We plan to give feedback sessions based on challenges/writing exercises set in small groups via Microsoft Teams on the following dates:

Thursday 7 th Jan	11.30am
Tuesday 12 th Jan	11.30am
Thursday 14 th Jan	11.30am

From today, a weekly reading comprehension '2do' will be set on Purple Mash for your child to complete as well as other curriculum related activities. Furthermore, it is also recommended that your child spends up to 20 minutes each day practising the times tables set on Times Tables Rock Stars and reading independently.
